Please, note that submission of an abstract automatically grants conference organizers the right to publish it in the conference programme and the proceedings.

Formal Paper Requirements:

The full conference papers should conform to the list below:

1. All papers must be prepared and submitted in MS Word format
2. Provide a 300 word abstract of the paper.
3. Abstracts should include the title of paper, Author(s) name, institutional affiliation, country, and contact information (phone number and email address).
4. In the case of co-authored papers, indicate who will be responsible for presenting the paper at the conference as well as the corresponding Author (if different)
5. Identify the institutional affiliation of all author(s).
6. Fully written papers should not exceed 3000 words or 10 pages (excluding references).
7. All papers including abstracts should be in Times New Roman, 12 size fonts, formatted and referenced in accordance to the APA style.

Important Deadlines:

- Deadline for submitting abstracts: **26 May, 2017**
- Notification of presenters with accepted abstracts: **9 June, 2017**
- **Full paper submission:** **18 August, 2017**

Presenters are to submit the complete paper in MS Word format (3000 words or maximum of 10 pages of A4 paper size with 12 size Times New Roman font typed double-spaced) and a Power Point version of paper to facilitate presentation at the conference.

Publication of Selected Papers:

The conference proceedings will be published in a book. Selected conference papers shall be published as articles in a journal.
